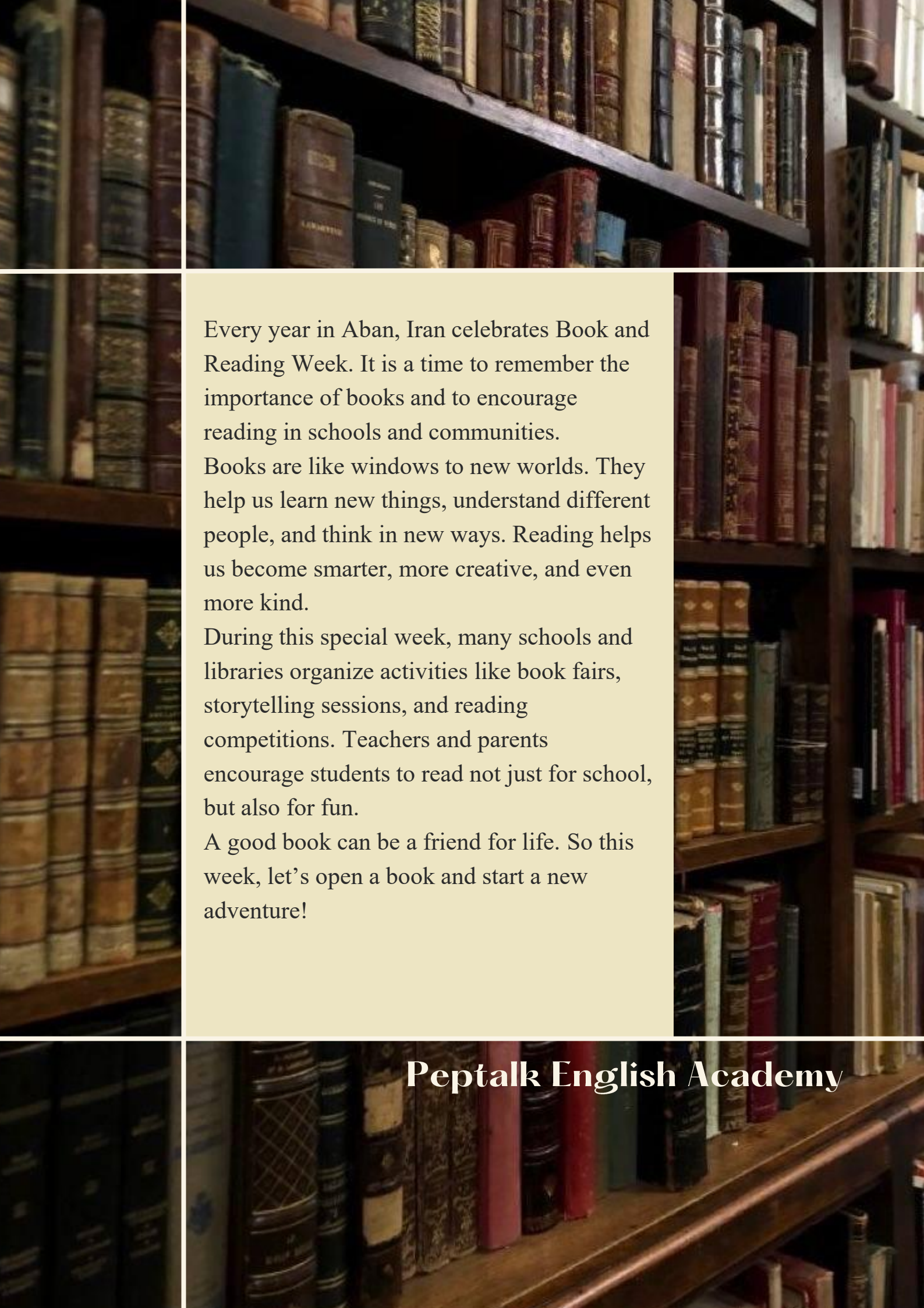




BOOK AND READING WEEK

Every year in Aban, Iran celebrates Book and Reading Week. It is a time to remember the importance of books and to encourage reading in schools and communities.

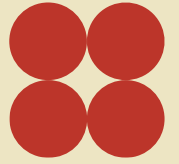
Books are like windows to new worlds. They help us learn new things, understand different people, and think in new ways. Reading helps us become smarter, more creative, and even more kind.

P.S.: We sincerely thank the honorable mothers whose presence and kindness completed the fragrance of this prayer. 🌸



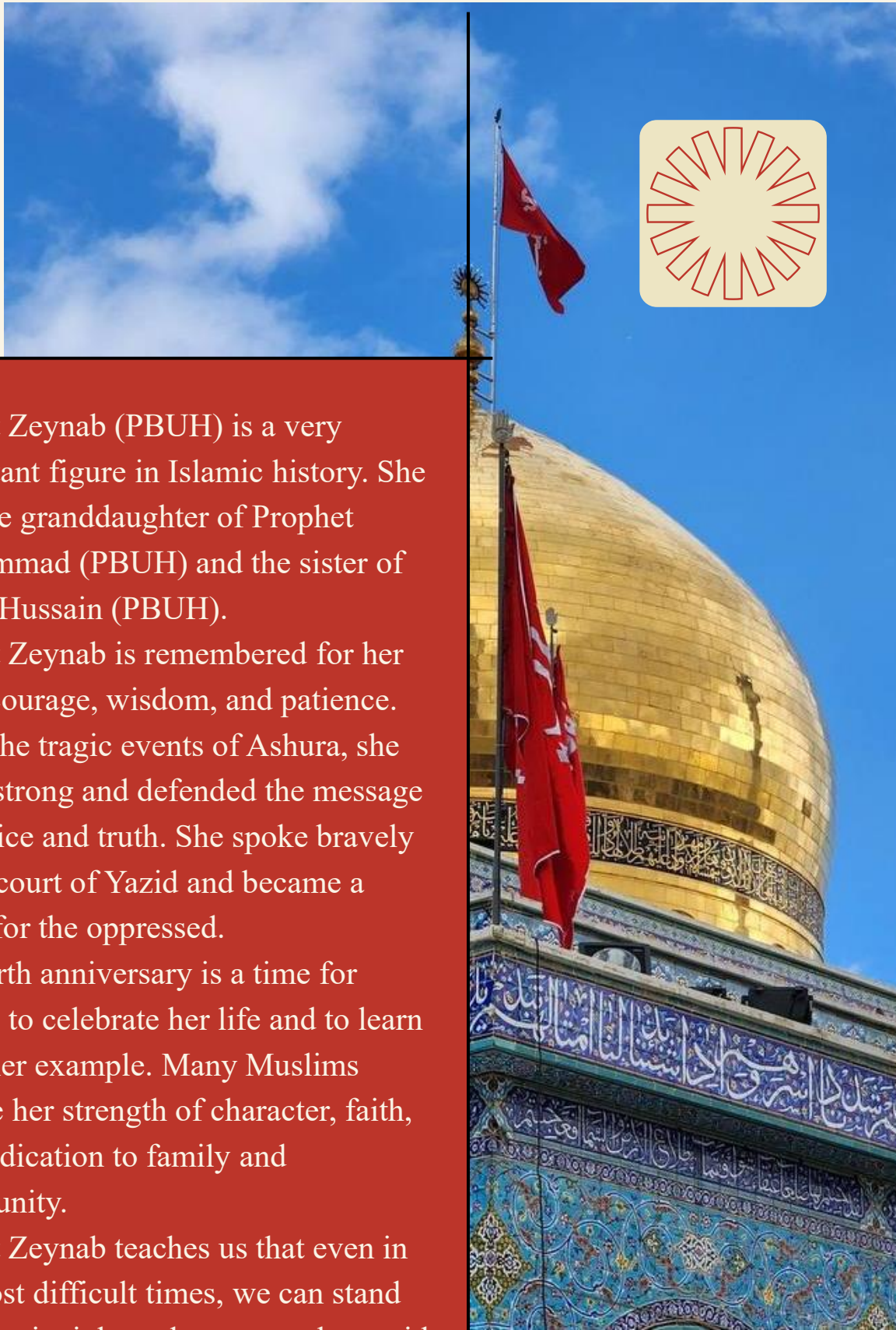

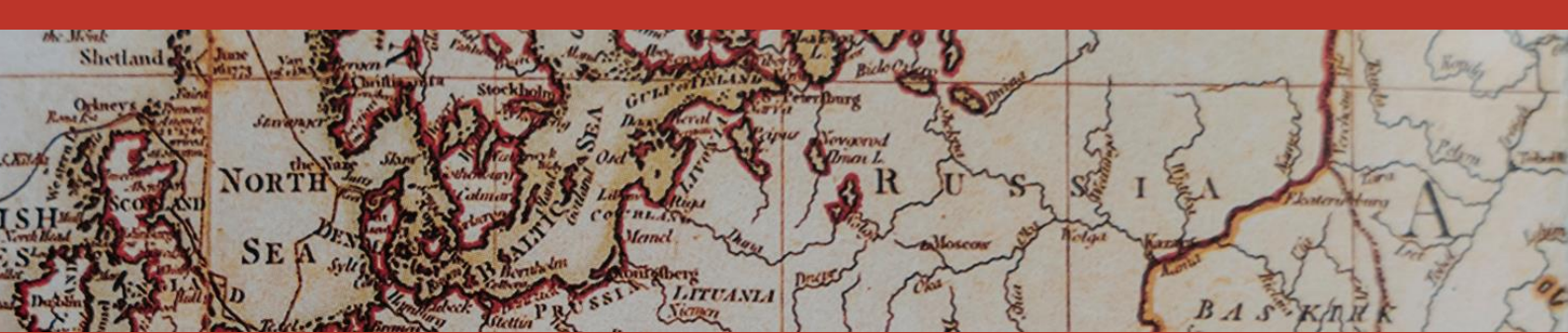
