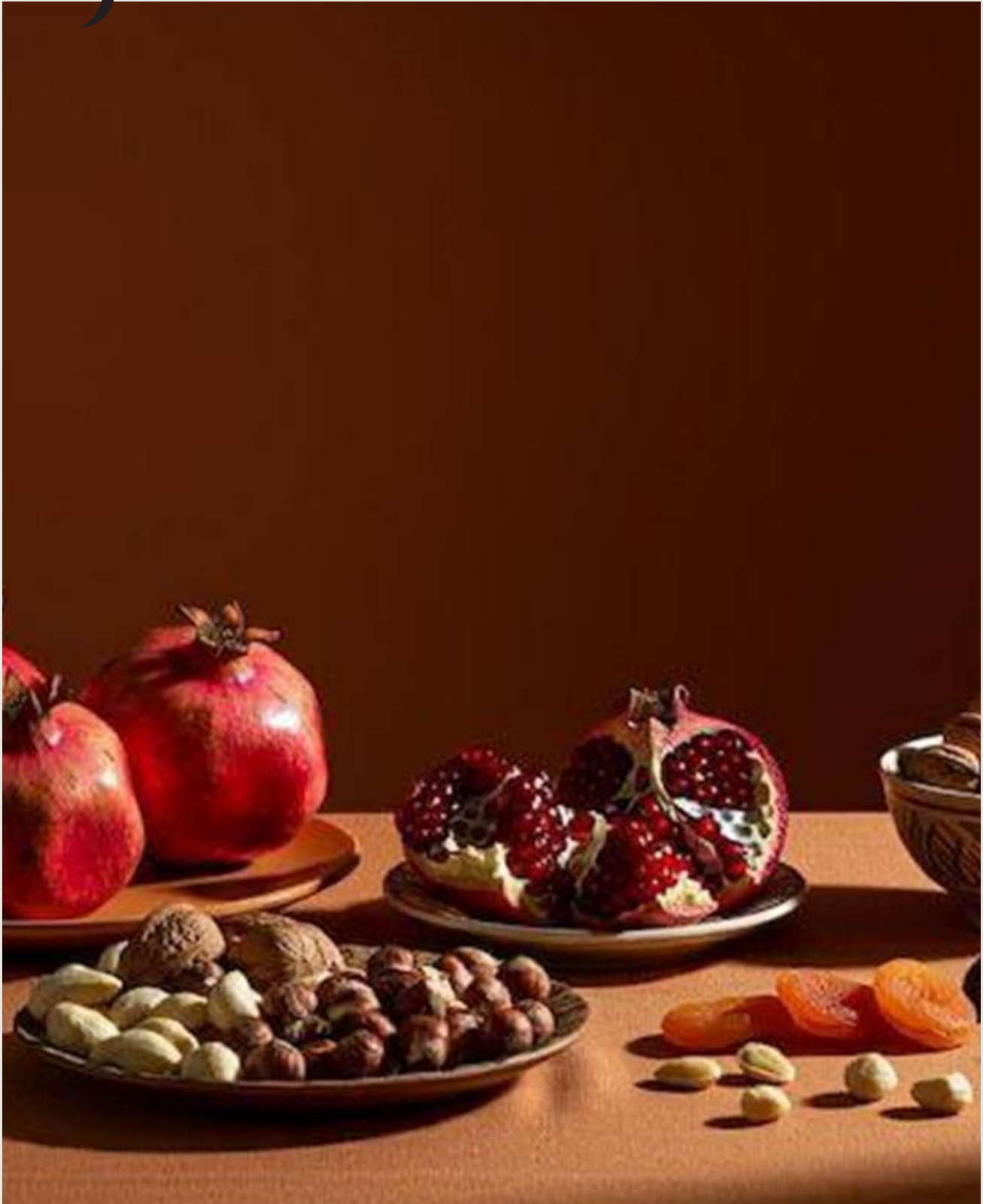

THE DEATH OF HAZRAT ZAHRA (PBUH)

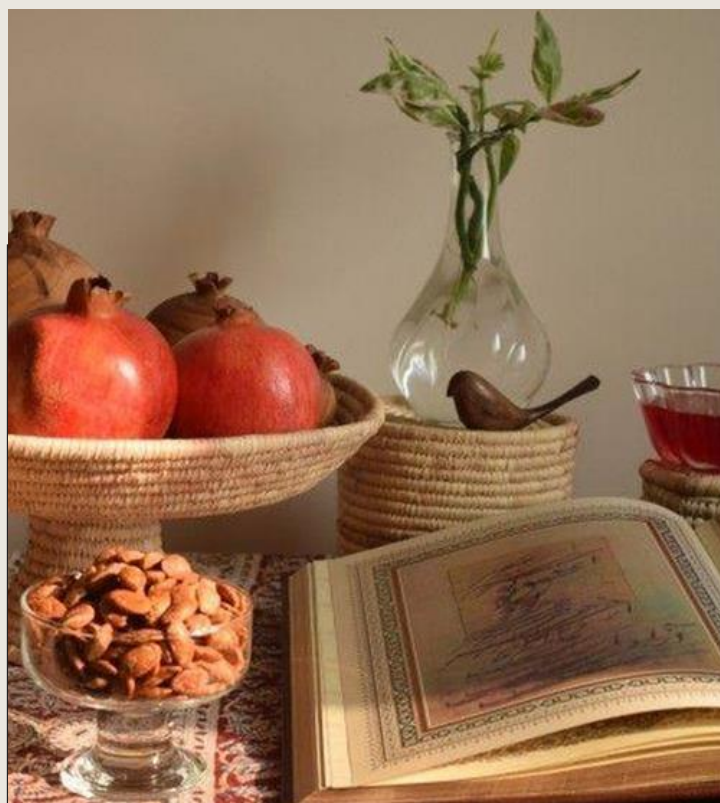
Remembering Hazrat Fatimah Zahra (PBUH)

I also like the evening because it is a quiet time.

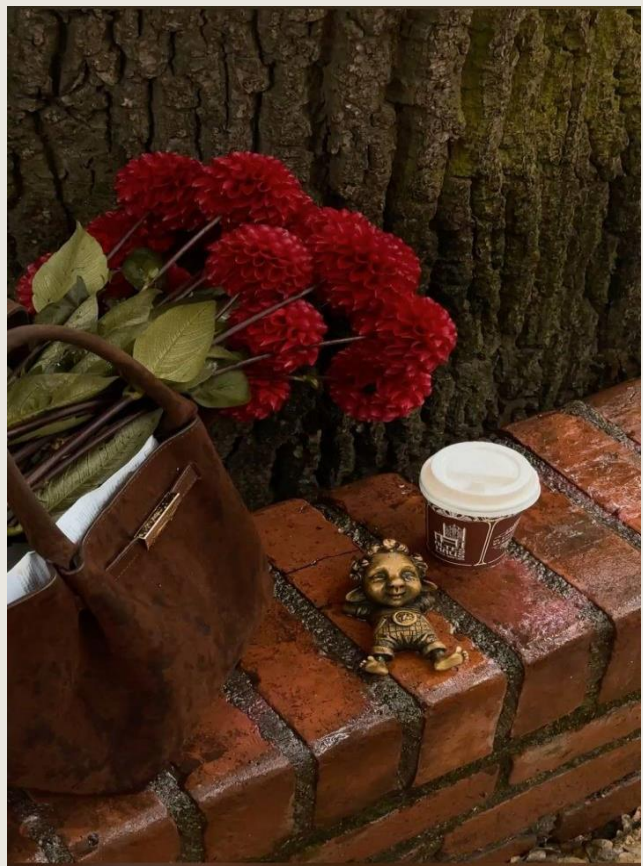

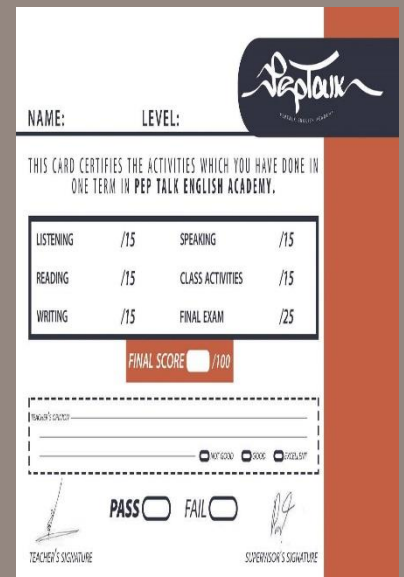
#Speaking

Hi, I'm Mahya. I would like to have the ability to fly because I love heights and excitement.

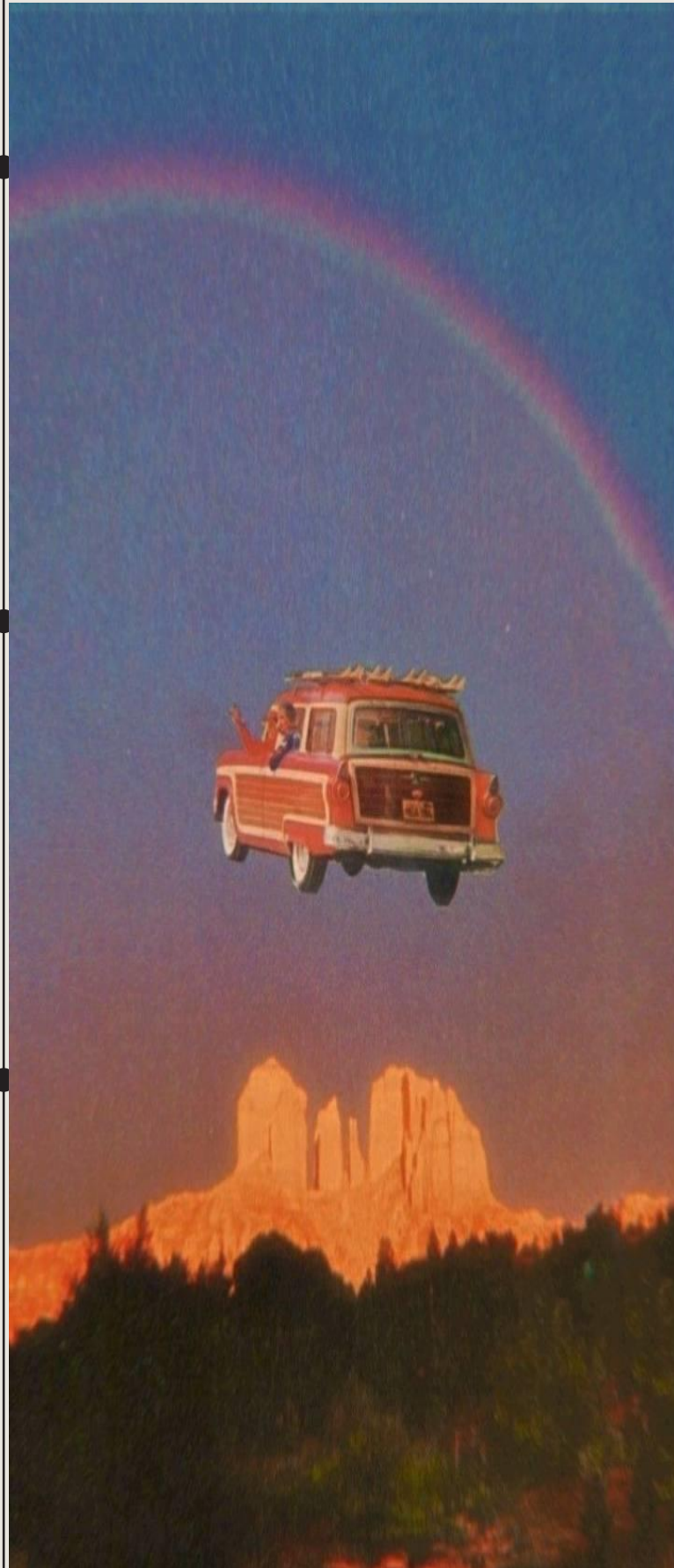
