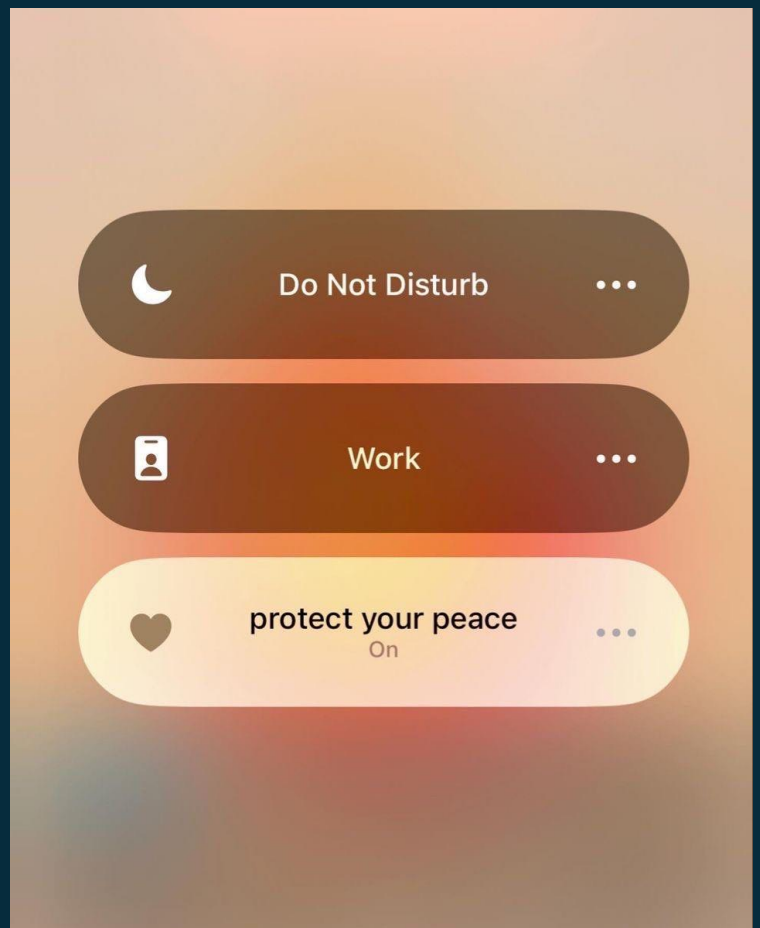
Nowadays, most people can't live without the

By the way, I prefer not lose it, so as a result, life is Boring and awful without the internet.

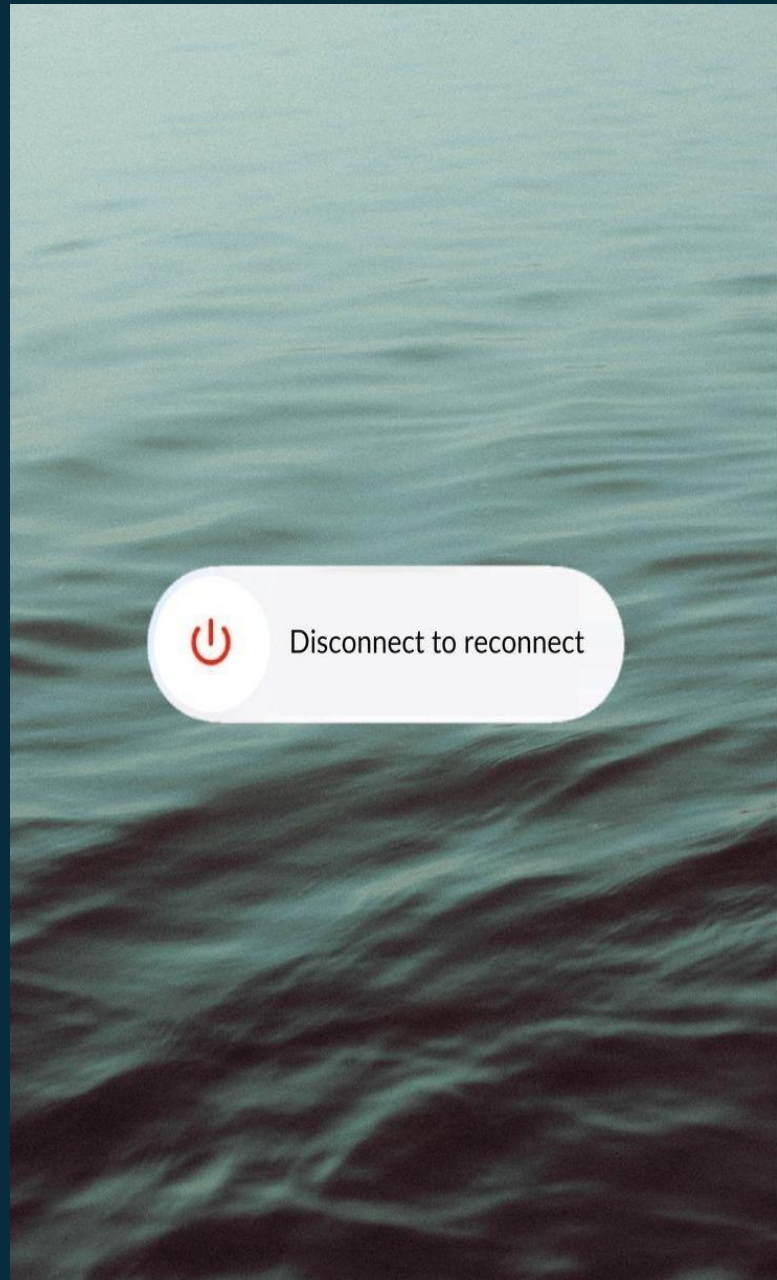
## *Fatemeh Gholami*

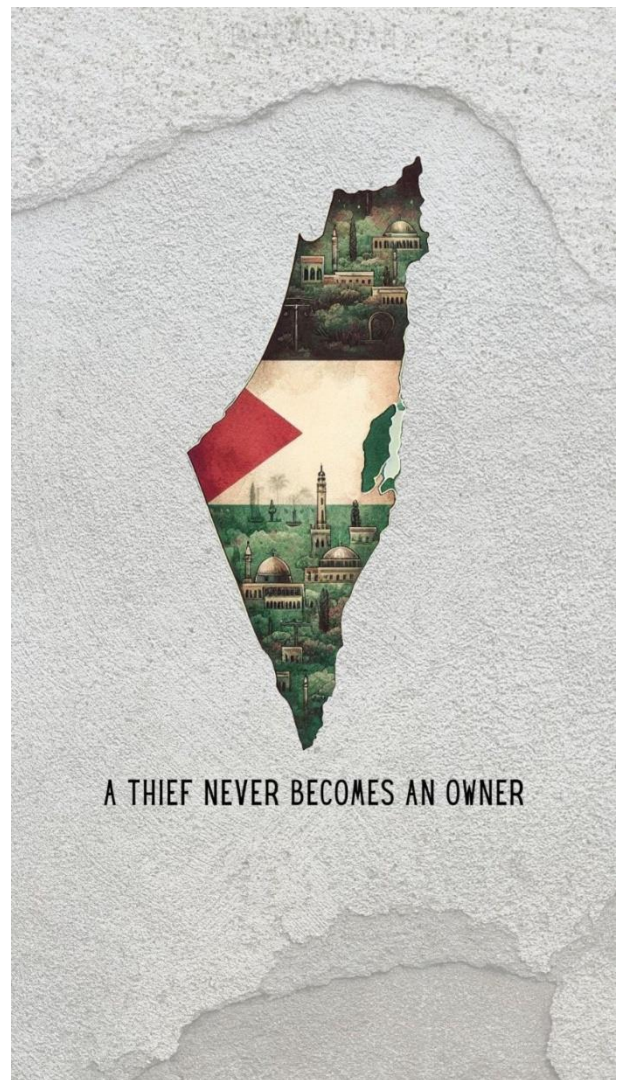

I often visit my grandma, too. We chat, drink tea, and sometimes cook together. It's a nice way to spend time with family.

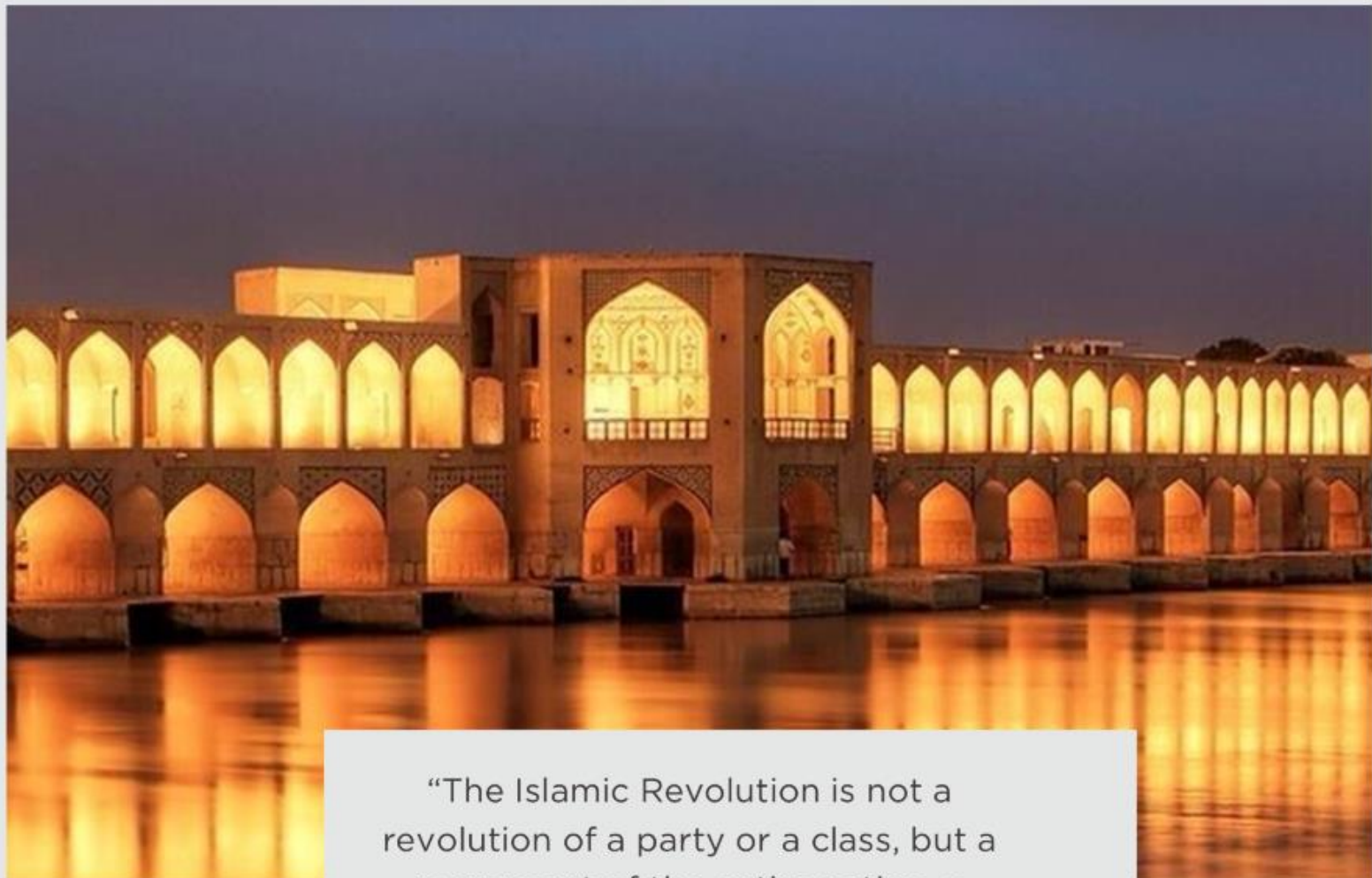
