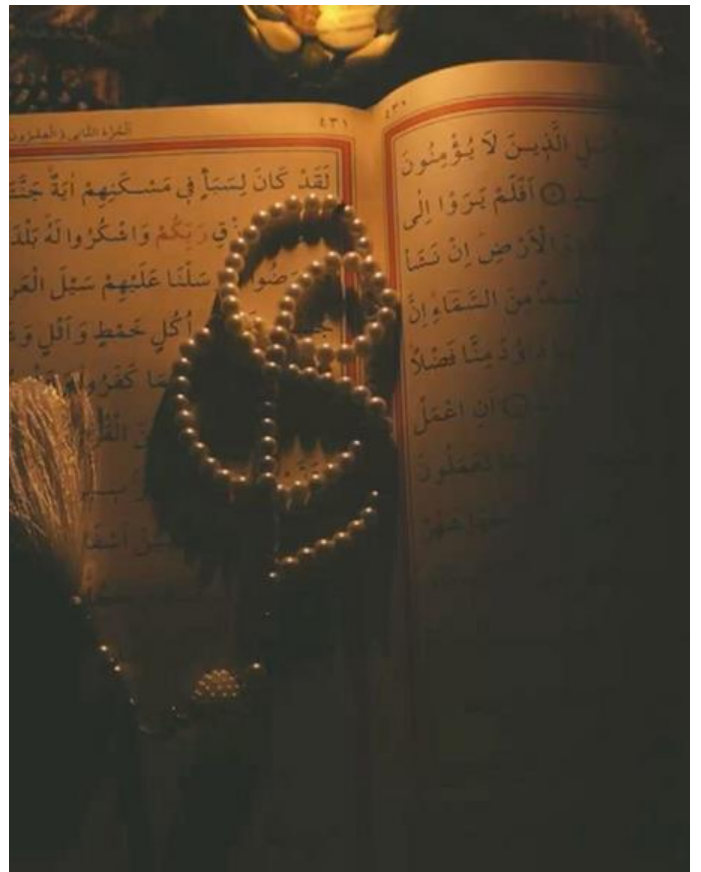




LAYLAT AL-QADR
